Dr. Tim Lightfoot is currently a professor in the Department of Kinesiology at the University of North Carolina- Charlotte. He earned a Ph.D. degree at the University of Tennessee in 1986. His area of research interest is exercise genomics.

The focus of his laboratory group has been to identify the genetic factors that regulate daily physical activity and exercise endurance in mice. Some of their studies have discovered specific chromosomal locations that control daily activity and maximal aerobic capacity.
